• Gyeongbok Palace

A particularly charming spot that represents a colorful and turbulent side of the capital's 500-year history. See the magnificent gates, graceful architectures and lovely gardens, all directly inherited from the Joseon Dynasty (1392-1910).

• National Folklore Museum

An excellent facility showcasing life and work, costumes and ornaments, handicrafts and technology, educations, living quarters, dietary life, oriental medicine, performing arts and games beliefs and rituals, and socio cultural life of the Korean people from the prehistoric age to the Joseon Dynasty.

• Jogyesa Temple

Explore the head temple of the principal sect of Korean Buddhism that emphasizes the Zen orthodox, meditation traditional and maintains the purity of monastic celibacy.

• Insa-dong

Clustered along the main street and a multitude of alleys that lead deeper into the district are numerous shops dealing antiques, oriental art supplies, and modern Korean arts of all types and styles.

• **Changdeok Palace**

Rebuilt in 1610 with more color and with a slightly different style of architecture. 13 kings used it as their official residence until 1926, except for a limited period of the time when the Gyeongbok palace was restored and used by King Gojong.

• **The 3rd Tunnel**

See the Freedom Bridge where 12,773 prisoners of war returned to freedom in South Korea.

Then, board a bus to continue on to the Demilitarized Zone (DMZ), where tension runs remain high.

Explore the highlight, The 3rd Tunnel, dug secretly by the North.



-Those who suffer from asthma, claustrophobia or a weak heart cannot enter the tunnel

-Tunnel tour is absolutely at your choice.

You could opt out by staying on the bus, in the exhibiting room or shopping in the store for souvenirs.

Next, stop at Dora Observatory and Dorasan station.

T-5 Afternoon- Korean Folk Village (13:00-17:00)
